# L-Shaped Folding Bench Seat Installation Instructions 

## Please read all instructions before installing products

Local codes vary from state to state. Check your local codes before installing the L-Shaped Folding Bench Seat. Consult the ADA Standards for any ADA Compliant installs.

## Note:

- Install bench seats into solid wall sub-structure or backing plates.
- These instructions are intended for wood stud walls and/or blocking. If wall conditions vary use fasteners suitable for the wall conditions on which the product will be installed.

1. Using a level, draw a line on the wall, 19 3/8" above the floor, where the L-Shaped Folding Seat will be installed. See Figure 1.
2. Remove the Folding Bench Seat from the box and place on a flat surface.
3. Unclip the hinge covers, slide them back towards the bench top and rotate them $90^{\circ}$ to the outside. See Figure 2.
4. Position the bench seat against the wall with the top mounting holes lined up with the line on the wall and place a mark at each hole location. See Figure 3.
5. Drill $7 / 32^{\prime \prime}$ pilot holes $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ deep into the wall at each hole location. See Figure 4.

Note: If installing onto wall cladding such as BioPrism ${ }^{\circledR}$ or tile, holes slightly larger than the fastner are needed through the wall cladding to prevent damage to the wall cladding.

6. Attach the L-Shaped Folding Bench Seat to the wall with the provided $\mathrm{M} 8 \times 70 \mathrm{~mm}$ lag screws and a 13 mm socket. See Figure 5.

Caution: Hand tighten mounting bolts to avoid damaging wall cladding. DO NOT TIGHTEN WITH POWER TOOLS.
7. Slide the hinge covers down the frame and rotate them inwards $90^{\circ}$. Snap them into place on the wall plates. See Figure 6.
8. Rotate the bench down into its finished position.
9. Adust the feet up or down to the desired height, the seat should tilt back approximately $1-2^{\circ}$. Once the feet are adjusted tighten the jam nut with a 19 mm combination wrench. See Figure 7.
